Recipe of the Month



MOM'S GINGER SNAPS

Ingredients

1 c. packed brown sugar

3/4 c. vegetable oil

1/4 c. molasses

1 large egg

2 c. all-purpose flour

2 tsp baking soda

1 tsp ground ginger

1 tsp ground cinnamon

½ tsp ground cloves

1/4 tsp salt

½ c. white sugar for decoration

Directions

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Mix brown sugar, oil, molasses and egg together in a large bowl. Combine flour, baking soda, ginger, cinnamon, cloves and salt; stir into the molasses mixture.

Roll dough into 1¼ inch balls. Roll each ball in white sugar before placing 2 inches apart on ungreased cookie sheets.

Bake in the preheated oven until the center is firm, 10 - 12 minutes. Cool on wire racks.
